



Church Planting

- 1) **Course:** MTC013, Church Planting
- 2) **Length** – 16hrs
- 3) **Course Description:** This course is designed to begin to equip leaders with models, principles, strategies, and methodologies for planting new churches that have an apostolic ethos of continual reproduction. It surveys Biblical materials on church planting, examines recent literature and resources, and evaluates successful church-plant efforts.
- 4) **Instructional Goals and Objectives:**
 - a) **Being (Spiritual Formation) Objectives:** The student will
 - i) have a renewed love for the Church.
 - ii) have a deep conviction concerning the Biblical priority of church planting.
 - iii) have a broken heart for the lost, especially for those who have no church.
 - iv) lead others by being a servant and a Chief-Repenter.
 - v) realize the priority of prayer and how to build a prayer team.
 - vi) understand the priority of having a clear call.
 - b) **Knowing (Cognitive Formation) Objectives:** The student will
 - i) understand why the church exists.
 - ii) identify a church plant's priorities in ministry.
 - iii) know how to determine the core motivations for ministry.
 - iv) understand how church ministries work together.
 - v) know how to raise and manage ministry finances.
 - vi) understand how to build a launch team.
 - vii) know how to lead and manage the church.
 - viii) understand how to personally survive and thrive in ministry.
 - c) **Doing (Conative Formation) Objectives:** The student will
 - i) begin to make decisions and plans to move into a church planting mindset and church planting activity.
 - ii) develop an intentional discipleship strategy which focuses on training local people to live and think with a church planting mindset.
