



Goals & Objectives

- 1) **Course:** MTC015 Knowing and Engaging in Your Community
- 2) **Length:** 4 weeks / 8 hours
- 3) **Course Description:** This course will examine methods which help students appreciate and make meaningful connections with people in the community in which their congregation or ministry is located. A major portion of the course is focused on developing skills and strategies to know and engage the local community.
- 4) **MTC Objectives:** MTC students will
 - a) ground their lives in the truth of God's Word.
 - b) translate their knowledge and skills into mission action.
 - c) serve as unifying mission leaders in their communities.
 - d) pursue ongoing learning for service in mission and ministry.
- 5) **Instructional Goals and Objectives:**
 - a) Knowing Objectives (Cognitive Formation): The student will
 - i) demonstrate an understanding and knowledge of the skills needed to exegete a community.
 - ii) demonstrate an understanding and knowledge of the skills and strategies needed to engage in community outreach.
 - b) Being Objectives (Spiritual Formation): The student will
 - i) exhibit characteristics of a spiritual missionary, whose habit for life and ministry centers in the Lord Jesus Christ found in Scripture.
 - ii) acquire an appreciation for the local community, its values, beliefs, and worldviews.
 - iii) seek means to communicate the Gospel by removing cultural and communicative barriers.
 - c) Doing Objectives (Conative Formation): The student will
 - i) demographically and culturally analyze a community.
 - ii) determine appropriate outreach responses for effectively communicating the Gospel.
